



CPSS guidelines for using the ongoing professional development (OPD) form

About OPD

Certified Professional Soil Scientists need to regularly demonstrate that they have gained sufficient professional development to ensure their professional skills and competencies develop in line with recent scientific and technological advances.

Submitting evidence of **40 hours of development every two years** is the minimum level of OPD that the Accreditation Board of Soil Science Australia (SSA) regards as necessary to ensure that CPSSs adequately maintain the currency of their professional standing.

CPSS-CSAM and CPSS-AusSS require a minimum of 20 hours of the 40 hours of OPD to be directly related to their specialty.

Excess points cannot be carried over between each two-year period.

A percentage of returns will be randomly audited each year.

If you have any questions about the ongoing professional development form pleased direct them to <u>accreditation@soilscienceaustralia.org.au</u>. Board consideration is available for those who might struggle to meet their points threshold.

Using the online form

Once you click on the link to the form you will need to login into the SSA member portal to be able to fill it in. Your name and email address will then show on the form.

The form asks for the following information:

- 1. Which two-year period you are addressing
- 2. Activity categories. The activity may address one or more categories. You cannot achieve OPD compliance in only one category.
 - a. Professional education and training
 - b. Professional development related to soil science skills and knowledge

- c. Professional service.
- 3. Activity date
- 4. Activity title and description (text)
- 5. Check CSAM or AusSS if claiming the activity against your specialty
- 6. Activity duration
- 7. OPD hours claimed for the activity (using the information in Table 1 below)
- 8. Evidence of participation/completion (see Table 1 for more information).

The form does not calculate your total hours - that will be a future enhancement of the form, but if you are logged in you will be able to see a table of all your activities and hours claimed for the period.

We recommend that activities are added as you complete them, rather than wait until the end of the two years. Please keep your own records of evidence as we will not keep them indefinitely on your behalf.

Showing 40 hours of claimable hours on your form does not necessarily designate compliance. You will be notified by email that your OPD return has been accepted.

Declaration

You can edit the activity up until you submit it. Please check carefully before you submit. If changes are needed please send an email to <u>accreditation @soilscienceaustralia .org.au</u> with the required changes.

You will be asked to check a box as a declaration before submitting that says:

I declare that the information submitted above is an accurate account of my professional development activities.
